CALL TO ORDER:

Mayor Gottman called the regularly scheduled meeting of the Vandalia City Council to order at 7:30 P.M.

ROLL CALL:

SPECIAL BILLS:

A motion was made by Cable and seconded by Feldpouch to approve all Special Funds as presented: Bluff Equipment in the amount of \$29,085.00 for a Kubota Tractor; Beelman Truck Co. in the amount of \$2,854.53 for CM13; Schmedeke Trucking in the amount of \$4,117.35 for rock; Vandalia Asphalt Service in the amount of \$69,583.92 for MC30 & HFE; GAC Mid America, Inc. in the amount of \$1,634.17 for chemical supplies; G.S. Robins & Co. in the amount of \$1,557.82 for chemicals; Van Devanter Engineering in the amount of \$1,825.11 for repairs to the Flypt lift station. Motion carried.
