Mayor Gottman reported that the ribbon cutting at the Starmax Cenemas was held last Friday.

Mayor Gottman received a letter from State Rep. John Cavaletto stating that the City of Vandalia will receive an additional \$30,290.00 for the Motor Fuel Tax Fund.

Mayor Gottman reported that the City is still waiting to hear from IDOT on what can be done to the bridge on Thrill Hill Road.

### CLERK'S REPORT:

Clerk Peggy Bowen announced that Joe Hill, Supervisor of Sharon Township invited the elected officials to the Kaskaskia College Vandalia Campus on July 24<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 P.M. to attend a presentation by representatives of the Township Officials of Illinois "on how to conduct board meetings."

#### STANDING COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Beesley stated that he was contacted by Rural Water asking if on the 185 side they could go from a 2" meter now to a 4" meter. They are concerned about the pressure.

Beesley said that he spoke with Public Works Director John Moyer and Water Plant Superintendent Marty Huskey and they did not have a problem with it.

Beesley did ask if the agreement needed to be amended and City Attorney Johnston said yes; but after review Attorney Johnston said no because it didn't mention the size.

Lester reported that the city received bids from three local contractors for the new cemetery building.

Lester announced that the Cemetery and Building & Grounds Committee will meet on Monday, July 7<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 to discuss the bids received.

Mayor Gottman announced that the lifeguard chairs have been removed at Vandalia Lake.

Removed due to no longer lifeguards are on duty at the Vandalia Lake and liability reasons.

Crawford announced that the Lion's Club Car & Truck Show will be held on August  $30^{\rm th}$  at the Vandalia Lake Marina.

The Grande Levee will be held on October  $3^{\rm rd}$  &  $4^{\rm th}$  in downtown Vandalia.

The Harvest Festival will be held on October  $4^{th}$  in downtown Vandalia.

The  $2^{\rm nd}$  Annual Armed Forces Tribute will be held on October  $11^{\rm th}$  &  $12^{\rm th}$  at Sonneman Park.

The South Central Law Dogs, a law enforcement motorcycle club, will hold its national rally in Vandalia in June 2015.

# FIRST READING ON A REQUEST FOR LIQUOR LICENSE FOR CIRCLE K:

A presentation from John Stanisz, business manager for Circle K, explaining that they would like to install the gaming video terminals in the Vandalia location.

Stanisz said that the state law states that gaming licenses can only be granted to businesses that have liquor licenses.

Circle K is requesting a Class A liquor license or a "pour" liquor license.

This was the first reading of a request for a liquor license from Circle K. The city council will vote on the request at the July  $7^{\rm th}$  meeting.
