APPROVAL FOR PAY ESTIMATE #1 TO PLUM CONCRETE CREATIONS FOR CEMETERY BUILDING PROJECT: A motion was made by N. Clark and seconded by Lester approving Pay Estimate #1 to Plum Concrete Creations in the amount of \$23,179.05 for the new Cemetery Building.

> Grant funds will be used for all of the costs associated with the building.

AUTHORIZATION FOR MAYOR TO SIGN LOAN PAPERWORK FROM LAND OF LINCOLN FOR NEW FIRE TRUCK: A motion was made by Beesley and seconded by Stunkel authorizing Mayor Gottman to sign the loan paperwork from Land of Lincoln for the new 2015 aerial ladder fire truck in the amount of \$710,163.00. Motion carried. APPROVAL OF TIF ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES FROM SEPTEMBER 8, 2014: A motion was made by Crawford and seconded by N. Clark approving the TIF Advisory Committee Meeting Minutes from September 8, 2014 as presented. Motion carried.

ORDINANACE APPROVING A CERTAIN TAX INCREMENT DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF VANDALIA AND VANDALIA PARK DISTRICT FOR \$400,000.00:

After some discussion on awarding the Vandalia Swimming Pool TIF funds, a motion was made by Alderwoman Crawford and seconded by Stunkel to give the Vandalia Swimming Pool \$400,000.00.

Alderman Swarm said that the city has a lot of other commitments and we do not want to run short.

Alderman N. Clark said that TIF money belongs to the citizens of Vandalia but unfortunately we do not have \$400,000 to give.

Alderwoman Crawford said that the city gave Vandalia School District \$65,000 a year for five years for the all weather track at the high school so we should be willing to help the community swimming pool.

A roll call vote was taken: Crawford, yea; Hobler, nay; Stunkel, yea; Beesley, nay; Lester, nay; N. Clark, yea; Swarm, nay. Motion failed.

Brian Stout was present representing the Vandalia Park District. He told the council that the park district has applied for a state Park & Recreational Facility Construction grant, with the maximum grant award being 80% of the total project cost.

Stout said, If the district receives full funding from the state, the district would not need to use TIF funding.

ORDINANCE #2014-9-15-D: APPROVING A CERTAIN TAX INCREMENT DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF VANDALIA AND VANDALIA PARK DISTRICT FOR \$315,000.00

A motion was made by Beesley and seconded by Hobler granting them \$315,000.00 which was the recommendation from the TIF Advisory Committee with a provision that if the Park District receives a grant that would pay for 80% of the project that would take away the TIF obligation.

Roll call vote: Swarm, yea; N. Clark, yea; Stunkel, yea; Beesley, yea; Hobler, yea; Lester, yea; Crawford, yea; B. John Clark, absent. Motion carried.

ORDINANCE #2014-9-15-E: APPROVING A CERTAIN TAX INCREMENT DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT CITY OF VANDALIA AND DENNIS & DEBBIE GRUBAUGH A request from Dennis Grubaugh for \$28,000 of TIF funds to go towards the roof repair on the old bowling alley. Grubaugh estimated that the cost of replacing the existing roof, soffit, fascia and guttering on the existing structure would cost \$68,134.00.

Alderman Lester said that he had questions about some of these values. Lester felt that the value is inflated.

Lester said that he took a look at the building and thought the roof could be done for \$24,000.00.

Lester said he felt that there was not enough information to make a decision.

Beesley said he received a call from an individual who does roof work and that contractor was very concerned that these numbers were off a bit, too.

After much discussion a motion was made Lester and seconded by Hobler approving \$15,000.00 TIF funds for Grubaugh. Roll call: Swarm, yea; Hobler, yea; Crawford, yea; Lester, yea; Beesley, yea; Stunkel, nay; N. Clark, nay; B. John Clark, absent. Motion carried.

AUTHORIZATION TO PURCHASE MATERIALS TO REPAIR TWO AERATORS FOR WWTP:

AUTHORIZATION FOR PUBLIC WORKS TO REPLACE WATER LINE ON SOUTH SEVENTH STREET FROM TOWER STREET TO DEAD END:

A motion was made by Beesley and seconded Hobler giving authorization to purchase materials to repair two aerators for the Wastewater Treatment Plant in the amount of \$4,810.00.

A motion was made by Beesley and seconded by Swarm authorizing the Public Works Department to replace a water line on South Seventh St. from Tower St. to dead end. Motion carried.

MAYOR'S REPORT:

Mayor Gottman announced that the new fire truck will be delivered tomorrow evening.

The fire truck will be on display for the public to view during the Grande Levee on October 4^{th} .

Mayor Gottman says the issue has been brought to his attention recently about different groups using road blocks for fundraising; especially the one at Sunset and Veterans.

Mayor Gottman is asking for input from the public on their views.

Mayor Gottman says one issue for the city is that they are permitted by the state.

Mayor Gottman announced that he will be attending the Illinois Municipal League meeting on Saturday in Chicago. CITY CLERK'S REPORT: City Clerk Bowen reported that the City of Vandalia received their first installment on real estate taxes from the county in the amount of \$447,720.02 in addition to the TIF District #1 in the amount of \$332,825.36 and TIF District #2 in the amount of \$91,117.84. Bowen reported that she will be attending a workshop at the Fayette County Clerk's Office in regard to the Consolidated Election to be held on April 7, 2015. Bowen reported that the first day to circulate petitions for the April 7th Consolidated Election will be September 23rd. Anyone interested can pick up a packet from her office next week. The first day to file will be December 15th thru December 22nd. CITY HIRES NEW POLICE Police Chief Jeff Ray announced that Dustin Cade has been hired as the OFFICER: city police officer and that he will be going through the Illinois State Police Academy. STATUS ON LITTLE RED Swarm asked the status on the Little Red Caboose. CABOOSE: Mayor Gottman said that work on the caboose has started and that the Assistant States Attorney Amanda Ade-Harlow is keeping close tabs on the case, to make sure the family members do the work promised though negotiations. APPLICATIONS BEING ACCEPTED FOR PUBLIC WORKS EMPLOYEE: Stunkel said that applications are being accepted for the position in the Public Works Department until Friday, September 26th. Applications can be picked up in the City Clerk's Office.

COMPLAINTS ABOUT IDNR AT VANDALIA LAKE:

Lester said that he has received complaints about the enforcement practices of the IDNR from boaters and campers at Vandalia Lake.

Several said that they would not come back to the Vandalia Lake due to the attitude and rudeness they encountered.

The council agreed to have Mayor Gottman and Chairman of the Lake Committee Mike Hobler talk to officials with the Illinois Department of Natural Resources about these complaints.

VANDALISM AT LINCOLN LOOP WALKING PATH: MALKING PATH: MALKING PATH: Mayor Gottman reported that the concrete pillars in the City Park near the Lincoln Loop Walking Path had been vandalized with paint, and that the city agreed to provide the paint and an employee to deal with the graffiti.

<u>CITIZEN'S CONCERNS:</u> Chip & Jane Berger addressed the council with concerns they have at her business at 511 W. Orchard St.

Mayor Gottman will have the City Attorney look into the matter.
