

Connor noted that Michel wasn't negotiating with a single individual, it was 7 to 10 people, all of whom represent varied interests they are designed to represent. Brosman stated it was a compromise with a lot of different opinions. Connor advised Michel to take the lease to her clients, have them review it, make

changes and then bring back to Council.
